

Prayer of Confession (Unison)

Gracious God, you call us blessed when we are persecuted for righteousness' sake, and when others revile us and utter all kinds of evil against us falsely on your account. Yet, we confess that we often shy away from discomfort and opposition. We seek the approval of the world, rather than standing firm in our faith. We persecute others when they do not fit our picture of faithfulness. We perceive persecution when we do not get our way, or when others get what we think we deserve. We celebrate persecution as a sign of your blessing, even when it comes from unrighteousness. Forgive us, Lord, for our fear and our lack of courage. Strengthen us to rejoice and be glad, even in the face of persecution, knowing that our reward is great in heaven. In the name of Jesus, the persecuted one, we pray. Amen.

Time of Silent Reflection and Personal Prayer of Confession

Leader: And all the people of Christ say,

Leader: Hear the good news, who is in the position to condemn? Only Christ. And Christ was persecuted for us, Christ died for us, Christ rose for us, and Christ prays for us.
