

Leader: Observe the sabbath day and keep it holy, as the LORD your God commanded you. **People: For six days you shall labor and do all your work.**

Prayer of Confession (Unison)

Divine Rest, you invite us into your peace that passes all understanding and to invite others into that rest as well. You welcome us to join in both the work and the rest that you have created us for, but we seldom keep the two in balance. We treat your gift of rest as an earned commodity instead of an act of grace. We do not consider the rest of others, expecting them to be available at our convenience. We allow the letter of your instruction to supersede the Spirit. Welcome us into your rest, help us welcome others into your rest, and may that rest energize us to do your work in the world. Amen.
