

Prayer of Confession (Unison)

God of life, we have too quickly deserted the grace to which you have called us. We stand self condemned, seeking the approval of humans rather than of God. We know that we have received the faith of Christ, we know we have been crucified with Christ and now live in his resurrection life, we know we are justified by Christ's faith. Yet we draw back into a righteousness that must be earned by works of the law, which no one can obtain by themselves. We rebuild the walls of separation that you have helped us dismantle. What is worse, we expect others to join us in this hypocrisy; we expect others to live by a standard that we ourselves cannot meet. Rebuke us, O Lord, to our faces, call us back to the faith of Jesus. Help us die once again to the human-made law that condemns us, and live in the righteousness of the children of God. Amen.

Time of Silent Reflection and Personal Prayer of Confession Leader: And all the people of Christ say, People: Amen.

*Assurance of Pardon (Galatians 2:19-20)

Leader: Through the law we have died to the law, so that we might live to God. We have been crucified with Christ, and Christ now lives in us. By the faith of Jesus the Christ we are forgiven!

People: Thanks be to God!

*Affirmation of Our Faith (Scots Confession - Unison)

We confess and acknowledge one God alone, to whom alone we must cleave, whom alone we must serve, whom only we must worship, and in whom alone we put our trust. Who is eternal, infinite, immeasurable, incomprehensible, omnipotent, invisible; one in substance and yet distinct in three persons, the Father, the Son, and the Holy Ghost.
